Hi Peter, I have organised the below products.

Norseal wood treatment. This is to be used on any timber not affected by sunlight. It can't go under the clear coatings as this will not protect it from breaking down.

Shipshape epoxy primer. This is for the exterior from the gunwale to the keel.

Antifouling for the hull below the waterline.

Single pack primer, undercoat and finish coat for interior work.

deck paint.

The exterior will be done in first Norseal wood treatment (2 coats)

Then a light sand with 240 sand paper and clean surface with metho.

1-2 coats of shipshape. Again a sand and clean surface with metho.

Below the waterline topflight antifoul.

Above the waterline Weatherfast premium enamel.

Inside surface

Norseal 2 coats.

Weatherfast grey primer

Weatherfast undercoat

weatherfast premium Enamel.

spas and topside in our Weatherfast poly clear gloss. As many coats as possible. (min5)

I will send all the appropriate information guides.
